

**TITLE: MCS Governance Board Policy J-003: Student Immunizations**

**LEGAL REFERENCE:**

6.12.2 NMAC	Health Services
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**PURPOSE:**

The McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board recognizes that student immunizations significantly reduce the probability of contracting certain communicable diseases, and thereby reduce the probability of spreading said diseases to fellow students and staff.

**POSITION:**

At the time of enrollment, all MCS students must present satisfactory evidence of starting or completing immunizations that comply with the schedules, rule and regulation of the public health service.


- A. The criteria for exemptions from this policy must be in compliance with 6.12.2 NMAC
- B. The MCS Director will develop procedures for implementing this policy.
- C. The MCS Director will promulgate regulations for enforcing this policy.
- D. The MCS Director create an evidentiary form to document compliance with this policy
