LEGAL REFERENCE:

6.12.6 NMAC	School District Wellness Policy
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PURPOSE:

The McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board recognizes that a coordinated school health program, involving communities and families, will facilitate a lasting change in student and staff health, thereby decreasing absenteeism, improving the climate for academic success and promoting a healthier lifestyle.

POSITION:

McCurdy Charter School endorses a Coordinated School Health Program that integrates plans for at least the following components:

- A School Health Advisory Council (SHAC)
 - Health Education and Life Skills
 - Physical Education and Activity
 - Social and Emotional Wellbeing
 - Healthy and Safe Environment
 - Staff Wellness
 - Health Services
 - Nutrition, and
 - Family, School and Community Partnership
- A. The MCS Director shall prepare a plan addressing the needs of each component.
- B. The MCS Director shall prepare a procedure for implementing the Coordinated School Health Program policy and the integration of all components
- C. The MCS Director shall develop a procedure for measuring and evaluating the implementation of this policy, which can then be reported in the Healthy Schools Report Card.
