TITLE: MCS Governance Board Policy A-002: Tobacco, Alcohol and Drug-Free Campus

LEGAL REFERENCE:

6.12.4 NMAC Tobacco, Alcohol and Drug Free School Districts

PURPOSE:

The McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board recognizes that a tobacco, alcohol and drug free campus contributes to providing a safe learning environment, improving academic performance, reducing exposure to habit forming agents, and promote attributes a healthy lifestyle.

POSITION:

McCurdy Charter School is a tobacco, alcohol and drug free campus. As such, MCS prohibits the use, possession or distribution of all tobacco products, alcoholic beverages and/or illicit drugs by students, staff, parents and school visitors in school buildings or vehicles, on the MCS campus and at school functions away from school property. Violators will be subject to disciplinary actions.

- A. The MCS Director shall establish procedures for communicating this policy to students, school staff, parents, school visitors and the community
- B. The MCS Director shall establish procedures for implementing this policy
- C. The MCS Director shall promulgate a regulation for enforcing this policy.
