

**TITLE: MCS Governance Board Policy I-001: Dual Credit**

**LEGAL REFERENCE:**

6.30.7.8 NMAC	Dual Credit
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**PURPOSE:**

The McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board recognizes the value of providing high school students the opportunity to enroll in college-level academic or career-technical courses offered by a post-secondary educational institution, and to permit those enrolled students to simultaneously earn credit toward high school graduation and a post-secondary.

**POSITION:**



MCS will endorse and facilitate Dual Credit program that allows high school students to enroll in college-level courses offered by public postsecondary institutions prior to high school graduation. Dually enrolled students may earn credit toward high school graduation and a postsecondary degree or certificate simultaneously as defined in NMAC 6.30.7.

- A. A dual credit student refers to students who have met eligibility requirements to enter the Dual Credit Program.
- B. Within the Dual Credit Program, MCS and its partner postsecondary institution(s) will enter into an agreement, MOU, which establishes student eligibility and course eligibility. Courses may be academic or career technical, but may not be remedial or developmental.
- C. Within this program, the postsecondary institution will waive tuition and general fees and MCS will fund required instructional materials in accordance with NMAC 6.30.7.
- D. MCS will transcript credit earned from the partner institution upon receipt of an official grade or transcript record.
- E. The MCS Director shall establish procedures for implementing this policy.
