**PURPOSE:**

The McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C 793, prohibits discrimination on the basis of disabilities of any MCS student. Extracurricular activities will be provided in such a manner as is necessary to afford qualified disabled students an equal opportunity to participate in field trips. Students with disabilities shall be transported with non-disabled students unless restricted by health or safety considerations.

**POSITION:**

1. MCS will support the participation of students with disabilities in school-sponsored Extracurricular Activities/Field Trips/Special Events.
2. MCS will develop appropriate plans and documentation to conform with the MCS approved 504 Plan.
3. MCS will consider the safety of students with disabilities participating in any field trip or other extracurricular activity as well as the safety of all student participants.
4. MCS will provide the procedural safeguards that are to be followed regarding a student with disabilities traveling on an activity bus.
5. MCS will provide training to students and staff regarding showing respect to each other and to those students with disabilities who are traveling with them.


**The MCS Director shall promulgate procedures to implement this policy.**


