

TITLE: MCS Governance Board Policy JJIF: Retiring Athletic Jersey

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the McCurdy Charter School (MCS) Governance Board Policy on Retiring Athletic Jerseys is established to provide a standard for recognizing a student athlete for extraordinary athletic performance while enrolled in MCS, has had a memorable career, has died prematurely under tragic circumstances, has had their career ended by serious injury or has supported MCS in an outstanding way and is highly worthy of the honor.

POSITION:

To be considered for Athletic Jersey Retirement, the student athlete will be evaluated on the following criteria (1-3 are required and the nominee must attain at least one other criteria (4-7):

1. The student graduated from MCS or left the school in good standing at least six (6) years prior to the date of nomination.
2. The student played for MCS for at least two (2) consecutive years in high school.
3. The student exhibited good citizenship, sportsmanship and character while competing for MCS and after graduation.
4. The student attained first team recognition at the local or district level for at least two (2) years and state recognition (first or second team All-State) for at least one (1) year during playing career at MCS.
5. The student was a school record-holder during career at MCS.
6. The student attained recognition for outstanding accomplishments in athletics at the high school or college level.
7. The student attained outstanding status in their field of study.
8. Other special circumstances may be considered by the MCS Jersey Retirement Committee set up by the Director.

The MCS Director shall promulgate procedures to implement this policy.
